2020-21 West Rusk Twirler Try-outs

Parents and Students,

Our date for try-outs for the 2020-21 majorette line was **originally scheduled** for **Monday**, **April 27**th. With school closures and concerns over the Covid-19/Coronavirus, **it is highly possible this date could change. The process of try-outs could also change.** The band directors, twirling sponsor and school administrators will make a decision on how and when we will conduct the try-outs. Safety of our students, faculty and community are our utmost concerns.

For now, this is what you need to do to prepare for try-outs since we do not know exactly when they will take place....

- You must be a member of the West Rusk Band to be a twirler.
- All candidates need their own set of batons. These can be purchased online or at these local music stores: Tatum Music, American Band Instruments or Mundt Music. To determine the length of batons you need to purchase, hold your arm out straight and measure from your armpit to the tip of your fingers.
- If a candidate makes the 2020-21 high school or junior high line, they need to be financially prepared to pay \$200 on the day of try-outs towards summer camps and uniform costs.
- All candidates need to learn the following fundamentals. There are YouTube video links on the "Raider Band" tab of our school website which will teach you step-by-step instructions to perform these fundamentals.
 - o Right & left hand Wrist Twirls
 - Right & left hand Forward Figure 8's
 - o Right & left hand Reverse Figure 8's
 - Right & left hand Flat Spins
 - Single Elbow Rolls
 - Two-Hand-Spins (Pass around back)
 - Thumb Flips (Right Hand Only)
 - o Right and left hand Four-Finger Twirls
 - Flat Toss
 - Vertical One-Turn (Bonus points)
- **Junior High Candidates ONLY**: This year, with the special circumstances, candidates trying out for the junior high twirling line <u>WILL NOT</u> be required to do a group routine and <u>will only be required</u> to do the above fundamentals.
- **High School Candidates ONLY:** This year, with the special circumstances, candidates trying out for the high school twirling line <u>WILL NOT</u> be required to do a group routine and <u>will only be required</u> to do a solo routine, the above fundamentals and the additional following fundamentals...
 - o Right and left hand Forward Vertical Split Fingers
 - Right and left hand Horizontal Split-Fingers
 - o Right and left hand Eight-Finger "Grapevine" Twirls
 - Little Joe Flips (from reverse figure 8's)
 - Right and left hand Time Toss/Backhand
 - o Vertical Two-Turn
